



The Romanian College of Physicians

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Dear Mr. George Greenwood,

In response to your second request on September 19th 2025, we inform you that the right to practice as a doctor in Romania is autonomous, subject to authorization by the Romanian College of Physicians (CMR) and the Ministry of Health, under specific Romanian law and regulations. Thus, the suspension or prohibition of the right to practice in another state (e.g., the UK, Sweden) does not purport to the Romanian authorized right to practice locally.

DR. RAGHEB NOUMAN was first registered in February 9th 2018 with the College of Physicians in Timiș county and held since then an uninterrupted practice license. The doctor's right to practice in Romania was not suspended during the time he practiced in the UK. In Romania, there have been no disciplinary procedures against Dr. Ragheb Nouman to end into a suspension, restriction or withdrawal of his right to practice. Additionally, we do not know of any criminal or civil procedures initiated against him that would result in a ban on practicing.

DR. ABDOOL MAJID VAHDANI was first registered in July 6th 2006 with the College of Physicians in Bucharest and held since then an uninterrupted practice license. The doctor's right to practice in Romania was not suspended during the time he practiced in the UK. In Romania, there have been no disciplinary procedures against Dr. Abdool Majid Vahdani to end into a suspension, restriction or withdrawal of his right to practice. Additionally, we do not know of any criminal or civil procedures initiated against him that would result in a ban on practicing.

DR. IONUȚ POEANĂ was first registered in October 7th 2019 with the College of Physicians in Bucharest and held since then an uninterrupted practice license. The doctor's right to practice in Romania was not suspended during the time he practiced in Sweden. In Romania, there have been no disciplinary procedures against Dr. Ionuț Poeană to end into a suspension, restriction or withdrawal of his right to practice. Additionally, we do not know of any criminal or civil procedures initiated against him that would result in a ban on practicing.

Of all these three physicians, the Romanian College of Physicians was not aware of the disciplinary investigation in the UK against dr. RAGHEB NOUMAN and dr. ABDOOL MAJID VAHDANI. The only case brought to its attention was that of Dr. Ionuț Poeană, about whom the Swedish Board of Health and Welfare notified the Romanian College of Physicians on May 7, 2024, during the mandate of its former leadership. The information regarding Dr. Poeană's disciplinary sanction was immediately forwarded by email to the Bucharest College of Physicians, where he was registered.

However, as we have already mentioned in our previous letter, the object of the disciplinary measures taken outside Romania consists specifically in the doctors' right to practice in the respective state. The Romanian College of Physicians is not in the legal position to impose a ban on any physician practicing in Romania based solely on the decision of the Regulatory body in the respective country.
