



The Romanian College of Physicians

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Dear Mr. George Greenwood,

In response to your request, we inform you that the right to practice as a doctor in Romania is autonomous, subject to authorization by the Romanian College of Physicians (CMR) and the Ministry of Health, under specific Romanian law and regulations. Thus, the suspension or prohibition of the right to practice in another state (e.g., the UK) does not purport to the Romanian authorized right to practice locally.

Dr. Iuliu Stan was registered with the College of Physicians in Cluj County since 2008 as resident doctor and held since then an uninterrupted practice license. The doctor's right to practice in Romania was not suspended during the time he practiced in the UK. In Romania, there have been no disciplinary procedures against Dr. Iuliu Stan to end into a suspension, restriction or withdrawal of his right to practice. Additionally, we do not know of any criminal or civil procedures initiated against him that would result in a ban on practicing.

The Romanian College of Physicians was not aware of the disciplinary investigation in the UK against Dr. Iuliu Stan. During the mandate of the former leadership, the Romanian College of Physicians was informed by the General Medical Council (GMC) — on March 19, 2024 — that the doctor had been removed from the UK Medical Register. However, the object of the measure taken in the UK consists specifically in the doctor's right to practice in the UK. The College of Physicians in Cluj county and least the Romanian College of Physicians are not in the legal position to impose a ban on Dr. Iuliu Stan practicing in Romania based solely on the GMC decision.
